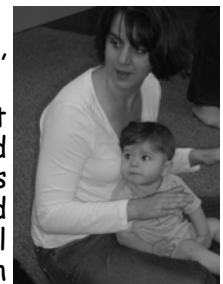

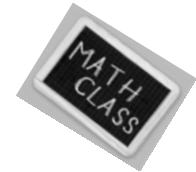

Music Lessons

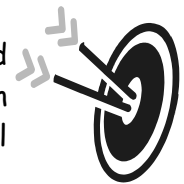
